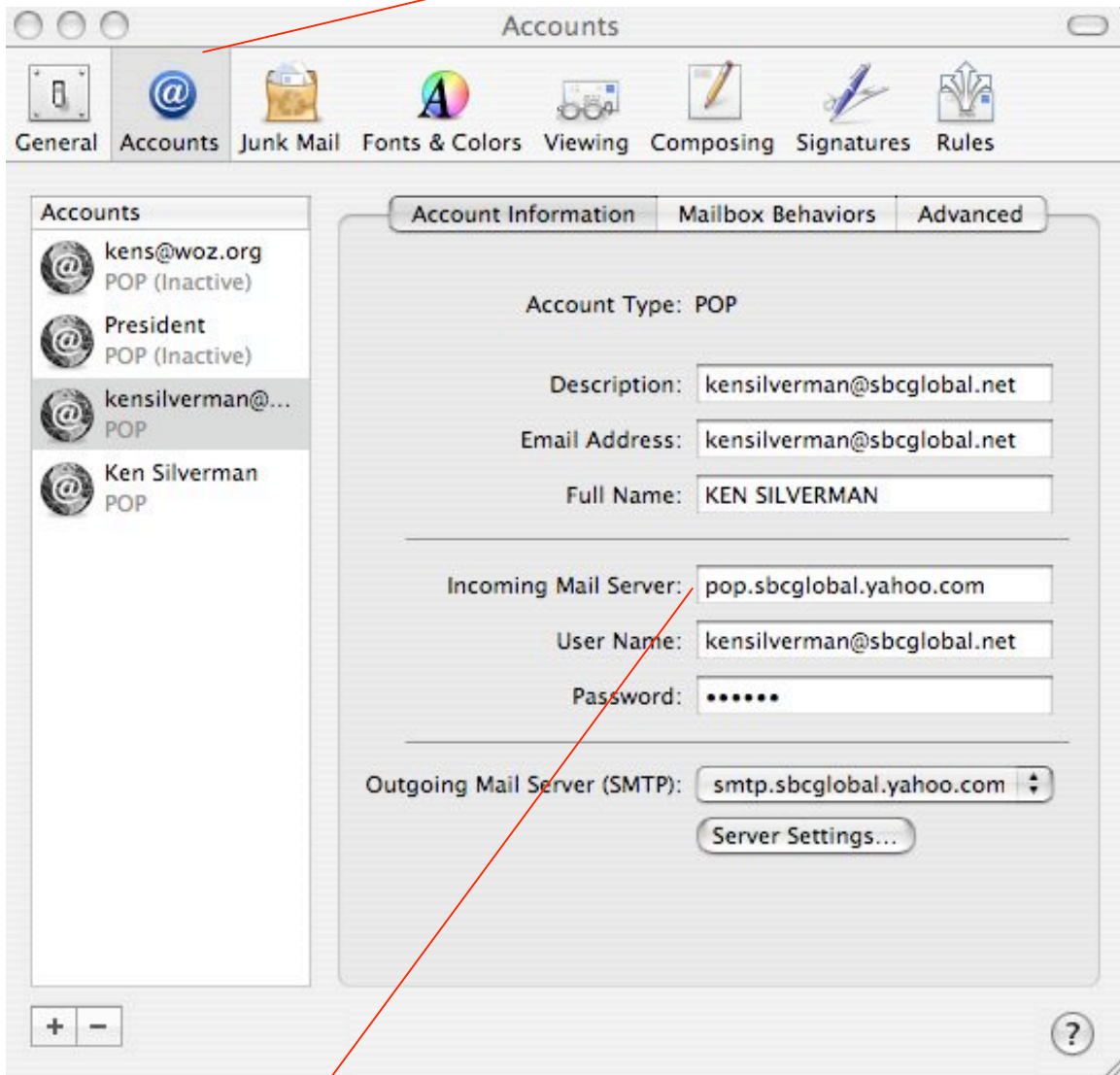


## Apple Mail

If you use an email account that ends with @sbcglobal.net and in addition use Apple Mail or Entourage, the following must be done to keep your mail working:

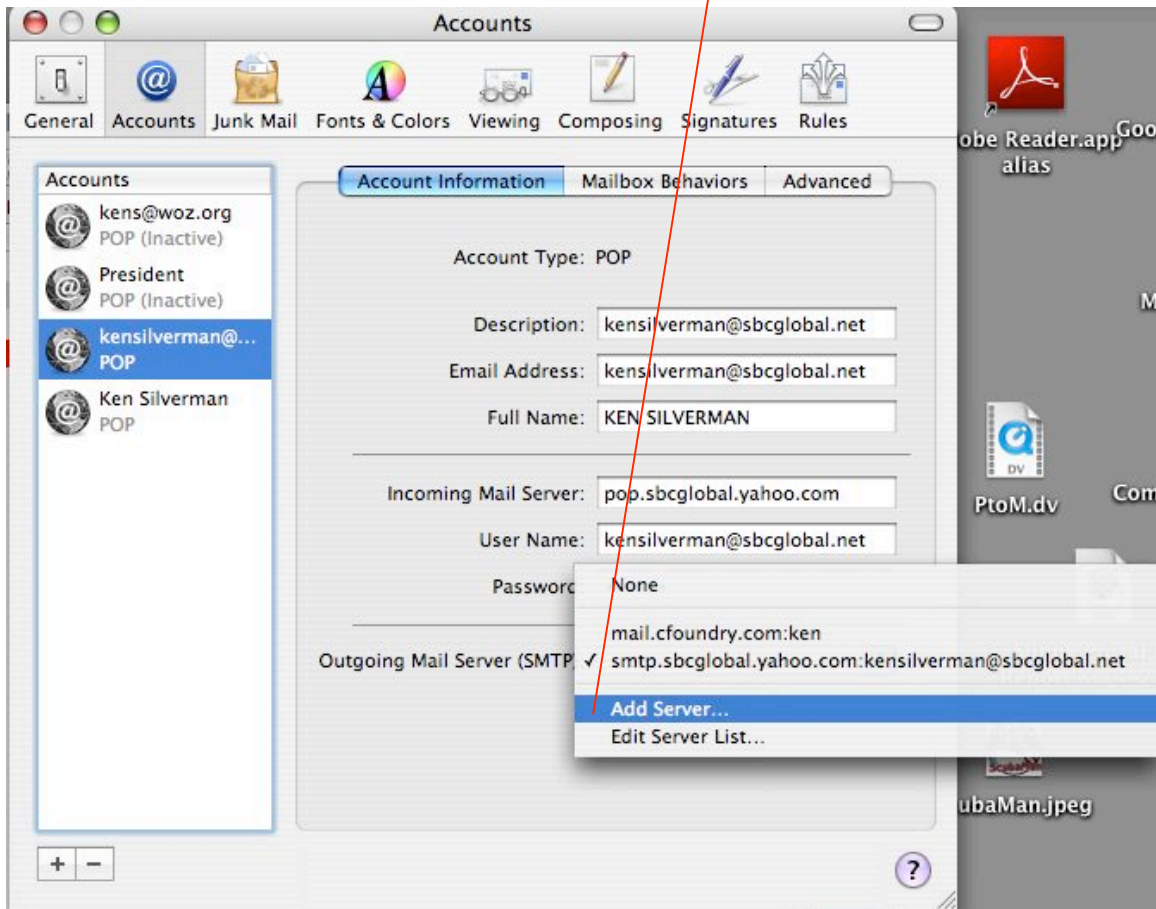
Changing from SBC settings to ATT:

1. Open Apple Mail and click on the word “Mail” at the top of the screen, go to ‘preferences’ and open them. Then click on ‘Accounts.’

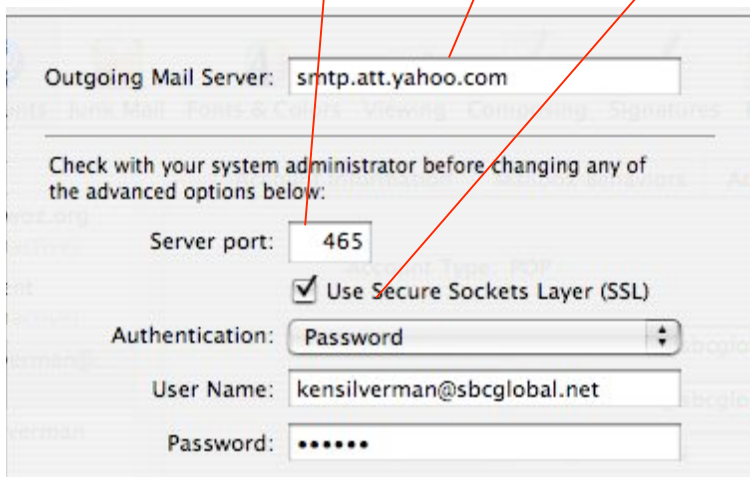


2. On the line ‘Incoming Mail Server:’ change it to read: pop.att.yahoo.com

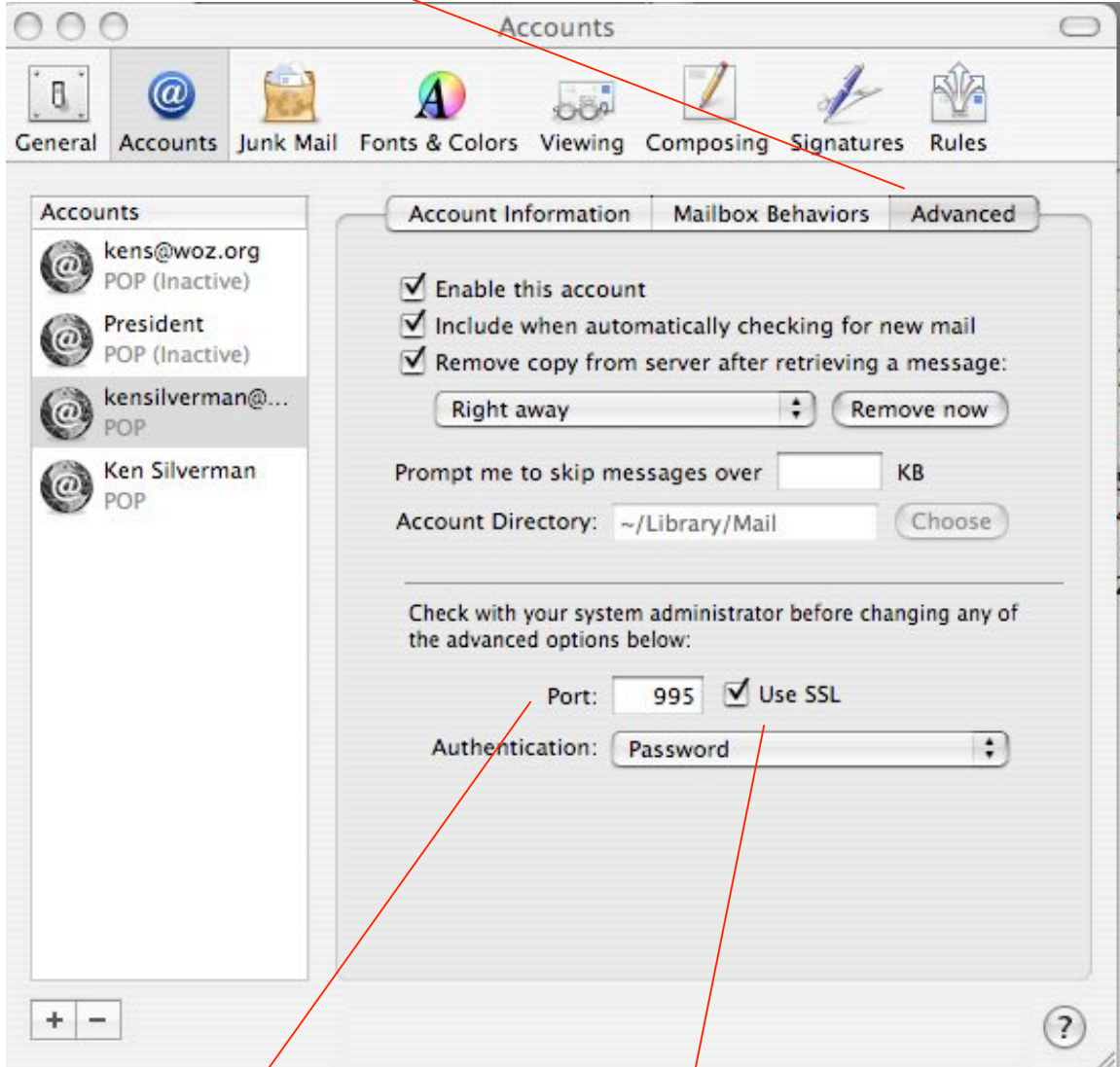
3. On the line 'Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP):' click on the line that shows 'smtp.sbcglobal.yahoo.com' and go to 'Add Server.'



Now you have to change the 'Outgoing Mail Server' to smtp.att.yahoo.com. In the Server port change it to read '465' and click on the 'Use Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)'. Make sure you have some dots in the Password line. If not put your email password in.



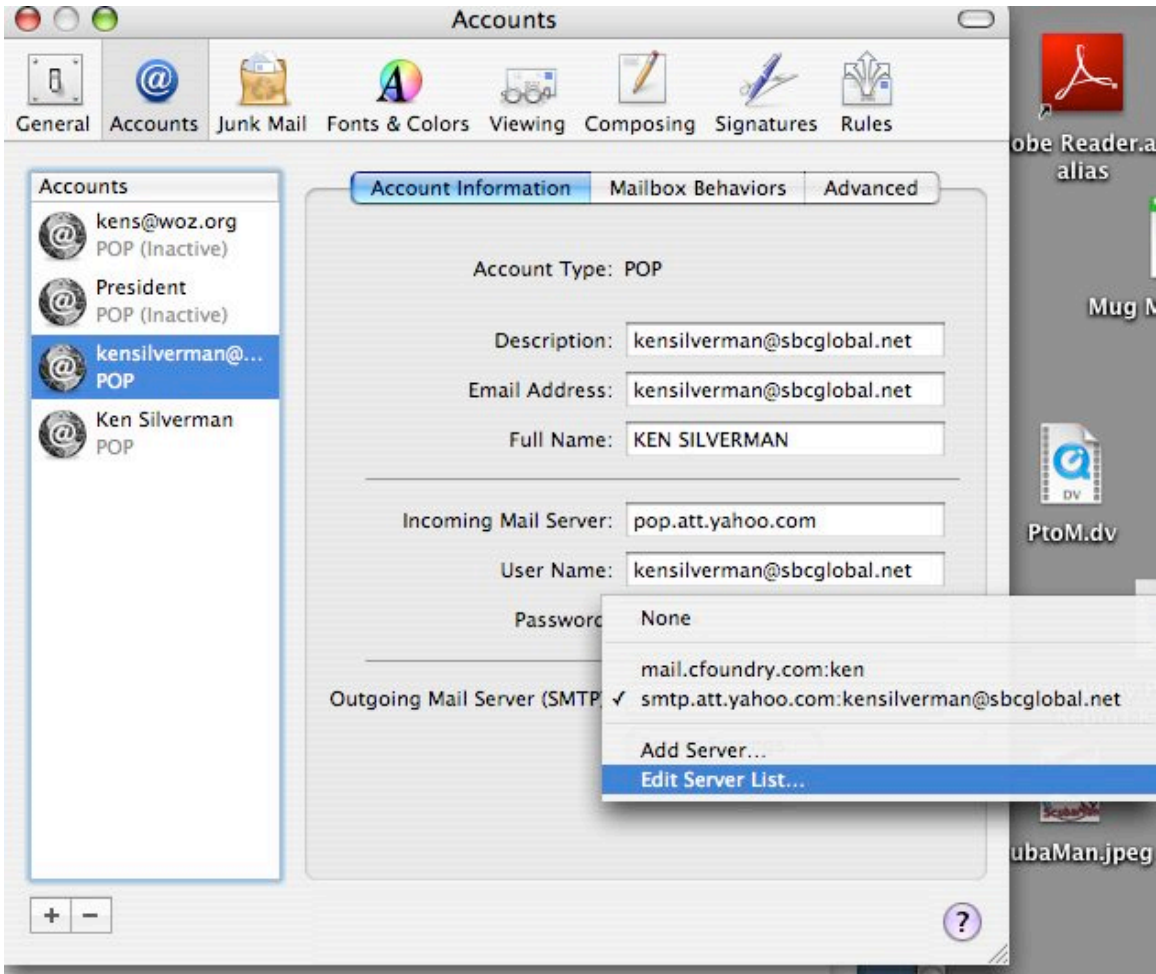
Now click on 'Advanced' button.



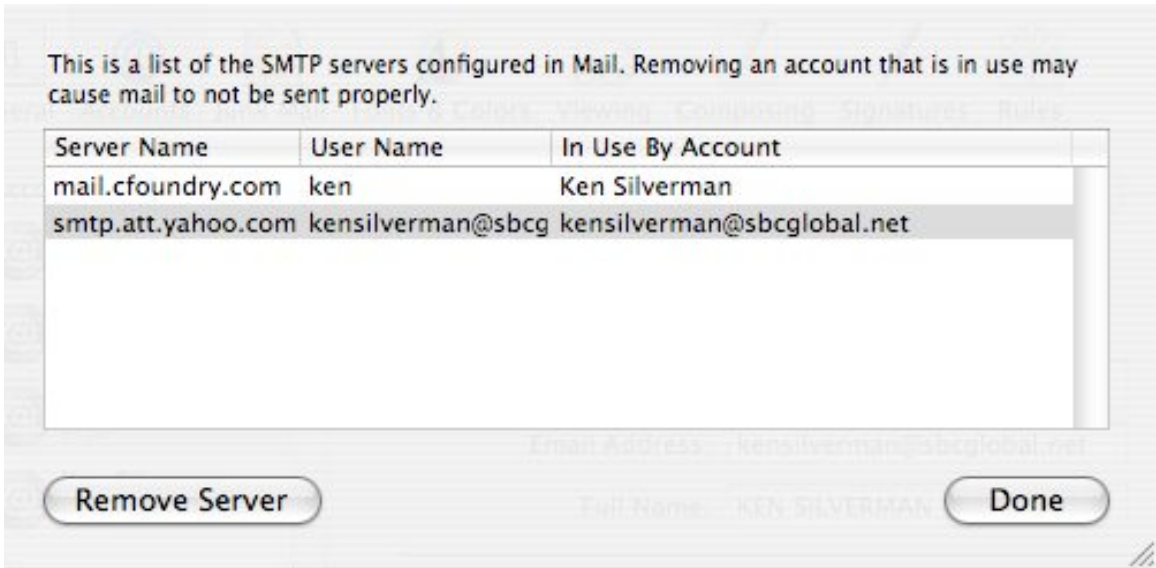
Change the 'Port' to 995 and click on the box 'Use SSL'

Now to finish it off:

Click on 'Account Information' and then where 'smtp.att.yahoo.com' is shown and in the pull down menu click on 'Edit Server List.'



Click on the smtp.sbcglobal.yahoo.com and click the button 'Remove Server'
